Our instruments are manufactured from the highest quality German surgical stainless steel (ASTM F899), are treated to be corrosion resistant, and meet or exceed the most stringent of FDA and CE certifications.

Our instruments have been tested with the Thermo Scientific™ Niton XL3t XRF analyzer and show no significant variation from industry standard for type 420 stainless steel.

GUARANTEE

Because of that, our instruments have a lifetime warranty against defects in material or workmanship when used for their intended purpose and when cared for according to industry standards. RETURNS

We strive to make our return process simple. Call (866-321-6331 or 520-398-5467) or email us (sales@medfix.com) to get a Return Material Authorization (RMA) number and shipping instructions. Be ready with the reason for the return, with your contact information, and invoice number (if available). All returns must have an RMA number or the claim cannot be processed. Replacements are shipped as soon as possible (depending upon availability), usually within 3 days of receipt of the returned item. Please package your returned items securely to avoid shipping damage.

We cannot accept instruments for replacement which have been altered or mishandled by the customer.
